INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 664-Representatives Peterson, Driehaus, Cassell, Hughes, Raussen, Setzer, Schaffer, Hartnett, Perry, Fende, Collier, McGregor, J., Blessing, Barrett, Chandler, Seitz, Wagoner, Oelslager, Stewart, J., Carano, Harwood, Evans, D., Yuko, Skindell, Wolpert, Smith, G., Blasdel, Uecker, Stewart, D..

To amend sections 5111.011, 5111.0118, and 5111.851 and to enact sections 5111.182, 5111.70, 5111.701, 5111.702, 5111.703, 5111.704, 5111.705, 5111.706, 5111.707, 5111.708, 5111.709, and 5111.7010 of the Revised Code to establish the Medicaid Buy-In for Workers with Disabilities Program and a Medicaid program for individuals who exhaust benefits under a qualified long-term care insurance policy.

H. B. No. 665-Representative Law.

To authorize a tax credit for former employees of General Motors Corporation and Delphi Corporation for education, training, and business start-up expenses.

Said bills were considered the first time.
